 - Not to take action that would violate Internet Number Registry System (INRS) uniqueness.
 - To take effective measures to promote Internet INRS.
 - To publish INRS entries publicly, so as to enable timely global Internet operations.
 - To cooperate together in the provision of consistent, effective global INRS

- RIR Cybersecurity
- Government Engagement

RPKI Program started in 2024.

The other programs will be reviewed by the NRO EC before start their implementation.

NRO programs are part of the NRO Budget.

NRO RPKI Program

Purpose: "To provide a more consistent and uniformly secure, resilient and reliable RPKI service"

Program Goals:

- Entities interacting with multiple RIRs are able to do so through a single spec interface.
- Improved transparency on the robustness of the RPKI system
- Enhanced security consistency of the RPKI system across the different RIRs

AFRINIC Situation

NRO EC has closely monitored the AFRINIC's situation by

- Providing on-site legal support
- Closed coordination with ICANN Leadership
- Looking for a renewed engagement with Africa Internet community in collaboration with other Internet organizations.

ICP-2 Review

ICP-2 it's a 2001 ICANN Internet Coordination Policy for the recognition of new RIRs.

On 25 October 2023, the NRO EC* asked the ASO AC to help with two tasks

aimed at strengthening the RIR system:

- ICP-2 Implementation Procedures: Review and advise the NRO EC on its draft of procedures for validating and addressing ongoing RIR compliance with ICP-2 ("Implementation Procedures")
- Strengthening ICP-2: Establish and manage a process to update ICP-2 in 2024/2025 to provide the RIR system with better accountability to the Internet community.
- A global consultation on the update on the ICP-2 document is currently underway organized by the ASO on behalf of the NRO <URL>
